**Dr. Akbar N. Khan**

Dr. Khan is a Doctor of Medicine 1992 (University of Toronto) with specialty training in Family Medicine 1994 (University of Toronto). He is the Founder and Medical Director of Medicor Cancer Centres Inc., the first private integrated cancer treatment center in Canada. Dr. Khan was first in the world to treat cancer patients off-label with dichloroacetate (at Medicor Cancer Centres Inc).
