- Students are concerned that their overall GPA has been affected by the CMS supplemental exam, which was recorded at 65%.

Dr. Tokiwa: The Academic policy highlights in course(s) with certain discipline or key components that if a student fails that component they have in effect failed the course. The supplemental exam is offered to a student as an opportunity to pass the course.
